Facilities: The SCRR has two separate ground level tracks, 4.75 inch & 7.5 inch gauge and an elevated track with 2-1/2'', 3-1/2'', 4-3/4'' & 5'' gauge tracks. Compressed air, water and electricity are available free of charge on site for locomotives and rolling stock. An electric hoist is available to assist in loading and unloading.

Safety Inspections:

- All locomotives and rolling stock are subject to be checked for gage prior to being run at the SCRR. The SCRR conforms to IBLS standards for wheel profile, thickness and flange depth. Non-conforming equipment will not be allowed to operate on the track due to the potential for track damage. This includes SCRR domiciled locomotives and rolling stock.
- All steam locomotives, steam tractors and stationary boilers must have up-to-date boiler inspection documentation meaning the last boiler inspection cannot be more than two (2) years old. If you need a boiler inspection the SCRR will have inspectors on site. Upon registering please let the registrar know that you need a boiler inspection. All steam locomotives must have a functioning ash pan.
- Tracks are available to all registered attendee's usage between sun up and 1 AM. Night running on any night, weather permitting. No whistle or horns can be used after 9:30 PM or before 9:00AM. You must display a headlight and a "FRED" (red lights face rear) when running at after dusk.
- See additional rules & regulations on the bulletin board in the main building.

Volunteers are needed; Members are sought to help with food service, cleaning, assisting with loading, unloading, steaming bay and other duties. Contact Meet chairmen at the email addresses or phone numbers listed below or at the Meet when you arrive.

Friends and Guests: Of members are welcome at the Spring Meet. All attendee's including members must register and pay a registration fee. Members are responsible for their guests and friends behavior and adherence to the safety rules of the St. Croix Railroad.

Animal Friends: Are allowed on a leash. The pet owner is responsible for the behavior of the pet. Any member with a pet that is deemed to be a nuisance or unruly may be requested to remove the pet from the property. The member is responsible for picking up after their pet. We are aware of members and guests with allergies to pets. Please be concentrate of others when moving around with your pets. Pets are not allowed to ride on any trains.

Accommodations at or near SCRR

Limited camping, motor home and trailer camping space is available at the SCRR. Maximum overall length is 28 foot. You must call or email Jim Culver prior to September 1st to reserve a spot. Limited electric hook up is available for the first come first served bases. Please park in your assigned space to prevent confusion and problems for your neighbors. Heated bathrooms and showers are available on site for campers. Please limit you shower time as a courtesy to other campers.
